

Moving Your Car Checklist

Moving interstate and need to move your car. Here are a few tips to help you when moving your car.

How it works

- Most companies will give you an estimate of when they can pick up your vehicle and when it will be delivered – there is usually a three to five day delivery timeframe.
- Before you sign any contracts, ask about the insurance options that the company offers. Your vehicle should be covered against damage or theft that may occur during transport. Also check what the excess on the policy is.
- You will need to complete and sign a vehicle inspection report which details the condition of the vehicle. Make sure you carefully inspect your vehicle and report accurately, describing its present condition, including windows, internal dash, seat condition, marks, etc as this is how your car should arrive.
- Don't pack belongings into your car, thinking that you can save on removal fees. Most companies won't allow goods to be packed in the vehicle or won't take responsibility for any loose items left in the vehicle.
- When the vehicle is delivered to you, inspect it carefully before signing. This is the time to note any damage or missing items. Take your time and check everything, both inside and out before signing any documentation.
